Noora Evaporation Basin Regulations

1. All none Field and Game visitors must report to camp site club house immediately on arrival to sign visitor's book for insurance purposes.
2. Visiting shooters (non-Loxton members) will be charged a \$20.00 fee per shoot. This money is put towards expenses incurred in the upkeep and maintenance of the basin.
3. Hunters must be financial members of S.A.F.G.A, carry current hunting permit with duck season endorsement, gun license and S.A.F.G.A membership card. Hunters are to produce them on request by Officers in charge of the shoot.
4. ONLY STEEL SHOT or BISMUTH ammunition can be used and bag limits will be strictly adhered to. Ducks shot are not to be pooled.
5. Inventory of duck species and duck numbers shot, will be recorded after each shoot. A book will be provided at the camp site for this purpose. All hunters are asked to fill in the book before leaving the basin after each shoot.
6. Hunters are required to follow National Parks and Wild Life Act and must comply with all requirements of the S.A. Firearms Act.
7. All feathers, gizzards, etc. from cleaning ducks to be placed in designated disposal pits.
8. All persons to camp in the designated camp site area, and abide by all camp site rules. These include maintaining a clean camp site and concern towards fellow hunters.

9. No rubbish is to be left in the hides and all used cartridges must be collected by the hunter before leaving the hide after each shoot.
10. Firearms are to be carried open and unloaded in the camp site area.
11. Noora Committee Members only to allocate hides to visiting hunters.
12. One person designated by the Field Officer/Noora Committee or person in charge of the shoot to commence the programmed shoot by firing the first shot at the time allocated. Any person who breaks this agreement will be immediately withdrawn from the shoot.
13. All dogs will be under control or adequately contained so as not to cause a nuisance to persons at all times.
14. Vehicles are restricted to specified defined tracks only.
15. Materials for the building of hides, is not to be collected in the basin or surrounding roadsides.

Any person not abiding by these rules may be asked to withdraw from the shoot. This shall also apply to any infringement of S.A.F.G.A rules and/or misconduct serious enough to warrant such action.

We seek your co-operation in complying with these rules as we do not wish to lose the licence to occupy this area.
